



Labcorp to Acquire Select Outreach Services from Ballad Health

Transfer of outreach services brings enhanced global resources to region, including expanded access to advanced testing, innovative digital tools for improved patient experience and achieves Ballad Health's goal of continuing to lower the cost of health care

JOHNSON CITY, Tenn. and BURLINGTON, NC, (Sept. 9, 2024) -Ballad Health announced today it has reached agreement on a strategic collaboration with Labcorp, a global leader of innovative and comprehensive laboratory services, to provide outreach laboratory services across the Appalachian Highlands region. This agreement includes the sale of select operating assets of Ballad Health's outreach lab services to Labcorp. The sale of these lab services, combined with Ballad Health's ongoing strategic partnership with Labcorp, aims to enhance patient care, expand access to advanced testing and improve efficiency for the health system and its patients.

Ballad Health will continue to operate its inpatient and emergency department laboratory, as well as lab services for hospital-based practices, such as oncology.

Brad Price, Senior Vice President of Regional Operations and Service Line Development at Ballad Health, expressed enthusiasm about the partnership: "We are excited about this collaboration with Labcorp, which will lower patient costs while offering expanded services and broader access. Labcorp's digital tools will improve the overall patient experience, aligning with our unwavering commitment to providing high-quality, accessible healthcare to our communities."

"When, for example, Blue Cross/Blue Shield of America recognized many of Ballad Health's services as 'high value and low cost' as Blue Centers of Distinction, it was because we act to improve quality and reduce cost wherever we can," said Ballad Health Chairman and Chief Executive Officer, Alan Levine. Combining their resources with those of Ballad Health will benefit patients and purchasers of healthcare in our region through improved and more cost-effective operations."

The organizations are committed to working together to plan and implement a smooth, thoughtful transition that maintains continuity of services for patients, hospitals, clinicians and clients, while providing direct access to the additional capabilities of Labcorp.

This relationship follows other strategic relationships that Labcorp has established with a range of local and regional health systems that have enhanced services for patients and providers.

The transaction is subject to customary closing conditions and applicable regulatory approvals. The companies anticipate closing the transaction in December 2024. Until that time, there will be no changes in operations or services.
